3. Is the patient asymptomatic (ie **not** experiencing any symptoms)?
Yes Go to question 4.
No The patient is not eligible for a Medicare rebate.
4. Is the patient is at high risk of developing breast cancer because they have 3 or more first or second degree relatives - mother, sisters, daughters, grandmothers, aunts or nieces - from the same side of the family who have been diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer?
Yes Patient is eligible for Medicare rebate.
No Continue to question 5.
5. Is the patient is at high risk of developing breast cancer because they have 2 or more first or second degree relatives - mother, sisters, daughters, grandmothers, aunts or nieces - from the same side of the family who have been diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer?
Includes any of the following features:
 - a. Bilateral breast cancer
 - b. Onset of breast cancer before the age of 40yrs
 - c. Onset of ovarian cancer before the age of 50yrs
 - d. Breast and ovarian cancer in one relative
 - e. Ashkenazi Jewish ancestry
 - f. Breast cancer in a male relativeYes Patient is eligible for Medicare rebate.
No Continue to question 6.
6. Is the patient is at high risk of developing breast cancer because they have 1 first or second degree relative - mother, sister, daughter, grandmother, aunt or niece - who has been diagnosed with breast cancer under the age of 45yrs plus another blood relative - mother, sister, daughter, grandmother, aunt or niece - from the same side of the family who has been diagnosed with bone or soft tissue sarcoma under the age of 45yrs?
Yes Patient is eligible for Medicare rebate.
No Continue to question 7.
7. Has the patient had genetic testing which has identified the presence of a high risk breast cancer gene mutation?
Yes Patient is eligible for Medicare rebate.
No Patient is ineligible for Medicare item number.
